### AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING SECTION 351.99 (a)

OF THE BROOK PARK CODIFIED ORDINANCES, ENTITLED 'PENALTY'

AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Section 351.99 of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances, passed by Ordinance No. 4526-1974, on January 3, 1974 and reading as follows:

### 351.99 PENALTY.

(a) Parking Ticket Violations. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter relating to parking ticket violations is quilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.

Is hereby amended to read:

### 351.99 PENALTY.

(a) Parking Ticket Violations. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter relating to parking ticket violations is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth third degree.

SECTION 2: Former Section 351.99 (a) of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances, as passed by Ordinance No. 4526-1974 on January 3, 1974 is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
