

**Public Notice:**

**Community Development Block Grant – American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009**

The City of Brook Park, Ohio intends to apply to the Cuyahoga County Department of Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) – Recovery Act, a HUD federally funded program being administered through Cuyahoga County. This particular program is governed by the same regulations as the CDBG program, but preference will be given to infrastructure projects. The maximum award available through the CDBG-R grant is \$500,000. Based on an assessment of the City's needs; the City is proposing to undertake the following CDBG-R activities: Infrastructure improvements for the Fairlawn Neighborhood which encompasses West 139<sup>th</sup>, West 147<sup>th</sup>, West 148<sup>th</sup>, West 149<sup>th</sup>, West 151<sup>st</sup> and Elm Avenue. This notice is intended to inform citizens about the CDBG-R program, how it may be used, and what activities are eligible, and to solicit citizen comments prior to the application deadline date of July 2, 2009.
