## **BROOK PARK PROUD**

The Recreation Center has always been a favorite place to go and has provided many fond memories while growing up in the City of Brook Park. Today, it continues to be the most popular gathering place for family, friends, and neighbors since opening in 1972. At that time, Brook Park was one of the first communities in Northeast Ohio to construct a Recreation Center. The facility was named in honor of the former Mayor, John A. Polonye, for his dedication and devotion to the betterment of the city. Through the years the building has gradually evolved. Highlights of the 1996 Recreation Improvement projects included Alice Hassing Outdoor Waterpark, Mini Gym, and an elevated indoor track. In 2017, renovations were made to consolidate City Hall, City Council, and Mayor's Court operations into this building.

The Brook Park Recreation Department provides all programs and facilities on a non-discriminatory basis for all citizens, regardless of age, race, sex, creed, or disability. Every effort will be made to accommodate all participants. If you need any special assistance to use our facility, please let us know in advance so we can make arrangements for your visit.

## **General Building Rules**

- All members and guests must check-in daily at the Front desk.
- Emergency exits are for emergency use only. Those who are caught exiting the building through an emergency exit non-emergently will be suspended.
- Children under the age of 8 years old must be accompanied by a parent or an adult (18 and older) at all times.
- There will be no food or drink permitted in the Gymnasiums. All food and drink must stay in the Snack Bar area only.
- All rules will be administered, enforced, and interpreted by the Recreation Department staff, Recreation Commission and/or local authorities.
- Appropriate clothing and footwear are required at all times.
- No tobacco, drugs, or illegal substances of any kind are permitted in the building.
- No person will be admitted to the Brook Park Recreation Center if, upon entrance, it is readily apparent that they have, about their person and or their clothing, a recognizable and deleterious odor of 2<sup>nd</sup> Hand Smoke from Marijuana or Tobacco. Sole discretion to deny entrance shall remain with City Employees. Any party failing to abide by the decision to deny admittance will be considered a Trespasser and dealt with accordingly.
- Profanity, yelling, verbal or physical abuse, rude or boisterous behavior is prohibited.
- Any and all conduct deemed inappropriate is subject to disciplinary action. The Recreation Director will review the situation and make a determination of proper discipline.
- Members and guests are **REQUIRED TO WIPE DOWN** all fitness equipment after usage. Sanitizer and disinfectants are conveniently placed throughout the building.
- We respectfully ask all members, guests, and visitors report all equipment malfunctions, personal injuries, and concerns immediately to a staff member.
- The City of Brook Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property of any kind.
- The use of the Recreation Center and/or facility equipment by an individual, business, or organization for monetary gain must first consult with a Recreation Staff member to discuss next steps.
- Memberships are non-refundable, non-transferable and good for one year from the date of purchase.
