

The Recreation Center has always been a favorite place to go and has provided many fond memories while growing up in the City of Brook Park. Today, it continues to be the most popular gathering place for family, friends, and neighbors since opening in 1972. At that time, Brook Park was one of the first communities in Northeast Ohio to construct a Recreation Center. The facility was named in honor of the former Mayor, John A. Polonye, for his dedication and devotion to the betterment of the city. Through the years the building has gradually evolved. Highlights of the 1996 Recreation Improvement projects included Alice Hassing Outdoor Waterpark, Mini Gym, and an elevated indoor track. In 2017, renovations were made to consolidate City Hall, City Council, and Mayor's Court operations into this building.

General Building Rules

- -All members and guests must check-in daily at the Front desk.
- -Emergency exits are for emergency use only. Those who are caught exiting the building through an emergency exit non-emergently will be suspended.
- -Children under the age of 8 years old must be accompanied by a parent or an adult (18 and older) at all times.
- -There will be no food or drink permitted in the Gymnasiums. All food and drink must stay in the Snack Bar area only.
- -All rules will be administered, enforced, and interpreted by the Recreation Department staff, Recreation Commission and/or local authorities.
- -Appropriate clothing and footwear are required at all times.
- -No tobacco, drugs, or illegal substances of any kind are permitted in the building.
- -Profanity, yelling, verbal or physical abuse, rude or boisterous behavior is prohibited.
- -Any and all conduct deemed inappropriate is subject to disciplinary action. The Recreation Director and Assistant Recreation Director will review the situation and make a determination of proper discipline.
- -Members and guests are **REQUIRED TO WIPE DOWN** all fitness equipment after usage with a small cleaning towel provided at the front desk. Sanitizer and disinfectants are conveniently placed throughout the building.
- -We respectfully ask all members, guests, and visitors report all equipment malfunctions, personal injuries, and concerns immediately to a staff member.
- -The City of Brook Park is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property of any kind.
- -The use of the Recreation Center and/or facility equipment by an individual, business, or organization for monetary gain must first consult with a Recreation Staff member to discuss next steps.
- -Memberships are non-refundable, non-transferable and good for one year from the date of purchase.
